In October 2018, Her Majesty's Chief Inspector, Amanda Spielman, announced details of planned changes to the way Ofsted inspects schools, colleges, FE and EYFS from September 2019. These changes will move Ofsted's focus away from headline data to look instead at how schools are achieving these results, and whether they are offering a curriculum that is broad, rich and deep, or simply teaching to the test. Ms Spielman announced that Ofsted will consult on the introduction of a new judgement for 'quality of education' which will replace the current 'outcomes for pupils' and 'teaching, learning and assessment' judgements with a broader, single judgement.

Learners First is delighted to be working with Nick Whittaker, HMI and Ofsted's Specialist Adviser (SEND), to offer a unique leadership opportunity for Headteachers, Executive Headteachers and CEOs to consider these planned changes in more detail and their implications as well as the wider role of inspection within the education and school system. Nick will talk about Ofsted's future strategy and the development of the education inspection framework for 2019. This will be followed by a round table, open discussion to consider the nature of inspection at a much deeper level, including themes such as:

- how leaders balance ethical and moral considerations with accountability to inform strategic decisions;
- the leadership tensions and dilemmas this juxtaposition creates (with particular reference to the curriculum);
- how leaders can respond more collaboratively to accountability; and
- what the terms 'capacity' and 'meaningful collaboration' might mean within this context.
