Wickersley School and Sports College (WSSC) is a nationally designated Teaching School within Learners First Schools Partnership and has a strong track record of sustained high outcomes and providing effective school to school support. Despite the many national changes across the educational landscape over recent years, WSSC has maintained consistently high levels of performance across all measures and since 2014 has been ranked within the top 6% of schools nationally. Mathematics is a key strength within the school. The innovative and dedicated mathematics faculty has achieved, and sustained, a positive Progress 8 Score of over 0.68 by exploring opportunities to continuously improve teaching and learning and by investing in the development of staff (the majority of whom completed their ITT within the school). This approach is underpinned by a strong school and faculty ethos, a willingness to adapt, the determination to teach mathematics to all abilities at the highest quality and expert use of data to ensure the greatest levels of progress are made by every pupil.

This interactive workshop will be led by the Head of Faculty and experienced Specialist Leaders of Education (SLEs) who will share more about the teaching and learning approaches within the school and the mathematics department specifically. Throughout the day, delegates will be provided with the opportunity to observe classroom practice and ask questions of the subject leaders to explore how these areas can support practice in their own schools and settings. The workshop aims to provide delegates with a first hand insight into:

- How the mathematics faculty functions within the context of the wider school;
- The strategies used to help pupils make best progress;
- The ethos of the department, including the teaching and learning vision;
- How data is used to inform progress and interventions;
- How lower ability pupils are supported to access the curriculum.
