The Leadership Plus Workshops provide an opportunity for current and past participants of the NPQ Leadership programmes (NPQEYL, NPQSL and NPQH) to apply the theory of their learning about implementation and change management to tangible, real-time priorities within their own context. Having completed or about to complete the summative NPQ Case Study assessment based on a fictional scenario, the Leadership Plus Workshops will provide senior leaders with the professional headspace, specialist coaching and network to align their real time school practices through the EEF implementation cycle. It will provide participants with the broader leadership knowledge, skills, and support needed to successfully implement evidence-informed practices in their own settings. You will be supported to work through the cycle, and align your contextual situation to the theory and measure tangible impact on children and young people. Join us for a series of sessions designed to signpost, frame and challenge you as you embark on your school/academy development priorities. Sessions will include contributions from leaders across a range of educational settings.
